Essential requirements

1. Tertiary qualifications in Coastal Management, Natural Resource Management, Environmental Engineering, or other degree-level qualification in a related field with significant experience.
2. Demonstrated sound knowledge and experience of environmental legislation, policies and contemporary industry best practice in coastal and estuarine planning and management and/or flood management or hydrology
3. Experience in delivering environmental management projects with demonstrated project management capabilities.
4. Ability to work without supervision and take the initiative to solve unusual problems using research, analysis and innovation.
5. Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively and effectively within a team environment.
6. Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to liaise, negotiate and prepare and present information to enable effective communication with a diverse range of stakeholders.
7. Experience and knowledge in contract management including budgeting and procurement
8. Demonstrated experience in leading a small team
9. Demonstrated ability to write technical and comprehensive reports.

Desirable requirements

1. Local or State Government experience
2. An understanding of Council governance processes and meeting practice
3. Relevant post-graduate qualifications including surface water hydrology or floodplain hydraulics or coastal management.
