Essential requirements

1. Conservation Land Management Cert III or equivalent with more than 2 years' professional experience.
2. Demonstrated recent experience in the identification and control of invasive weeds common to NSW.
3. Demonstrated experience in developing and implementing weed management plans.
4. Knowledge of native and introduced flora and fauna identification
5. Experience with data collection using Geographic Information Systems
6. Experience in planning and carrying out improvements and maintenance of NRM assets such as fauna fences and furniture.
7. Demonstrated ability to manage operations safely in a remote setting.
8. Demonstrated ability to work cooperatively in a team setting.
9. Demonstrated ability to interpret and enforce relevant legislation.
