Essential requirements

1. Degree in Civil Engineering or other relevant engineering discipline recognised by Engineers Australia;
2. Demonstrated knowledge and experience in the planning, programming and undertaking of civil infrastructure maintenance or construction works, such as roads, stormwater, water and sewer.
3. Ability to use spreadsheets, word processing and project planning software.
4. Construction Industry White Card and knowledge of WHS Legislation and its application to road/civil works.
5. Knowledge and awareness of relevant NSW legislation - Local Government Act, Roads Act, Civil Liabilities Act, Water Management Act, Environmental Legislation.
6. Sound oral and written communication skills including sensitivity to managing expectations when dealing with the community.
7. Ability to work as part of a team and to also work unsupervised and still achieve the required outputs.

Desirable requirements

1. Working knowledge of and experience in the planning and delivery of minor civil works in particular Local Government Infrastructure.
2. Understanding of Continuous Improvement Programs and Quality Management Process.
