Essential requirements

1. Recent relevant experienced in the water, sewer or construction industry and willingness to obtain a Certificate III in Water Industry Operations
2. Knowledge of and/or experience in operation and maintenance of pumping systems, chemical dosing systems and/or mobile plant and equipment
3. Proven experience and ability to work unsupervised and in a team environment
4. Proven ability to use a computer, including mobile devices and software applications and demonstrated ability to learn other key systems including remote telemetry systems (ClearSCADA)
5. Demonstrated knowledge of obligations under Work Health and Safety legislation
6. Sound communications, literacy and numeracy skills
7. Ability to participate in the after-hours on-call roster
8. Hold and maintain a current NSW Drivers Licence & Construction Induction Certificate (NSW White Card)

Desirable requirements

1. Hold a Certificate III in Water Industry Operations or currently studying to complete, or have a relevant trade qualification.
2. Demonstrated experience with operating Wastewater Treatment Plants and/or dewatering systems
3. Hold and maintain a current NSW HR Drivers Licence
4. Hold current Industry relevant WorkCover or technical certificates or competencies (such as Confined Space, Working at Heights, Traffic Controller, vehicle mounted crane operation, Forklift)
